Blue Beret Charitable Trust & The Rawthey Project

Who are they?

They are all volunteers.

They are all ex-soldiers and officers who are known and trusted by those who have served in the most challenging conflict zones around the world.

They can intervene locally and immediately.

They have a uk wide support network of 127 mentors currently supporting 112 beneficiaries, 59 of whom are still serving.

Who do they help?

We support the most disadvantaged and vulnerable serving and ex-service personnel and their families, who maybe struggling to adjust to civilian life following the traumas of war, or who maybe tackling homelessness, drink & drug abuse, criminality, financial insolvency, long-term unemployment and psychological illness.

What can they do to help?

Screening

We start by providing a private full and in-depth clinical psychological assessment, this helps us understand the issues at the root cause of the situation. If we don't address the root cause, regardless of what we do, success will not be sustainable. The output is the production of a bespoke individual recovery plan.

Individual Development

This module culminates in a 7 day residential course, where the individual identifies the root causes of their situation themselves and develops plans to break the cycle of misery to achieve their life goals.

Blue Beret Charitable Trust & The Rawthey Project

Life Skills

This 5-day residential module is supported by professionals from DWP, finance, accommodation, housing, employment, education and training with the output crystallising the detail in the individual recovery plan.

Employment, Education, Training

Armed with the skills, knowledge, rekindled self confidence and a mentor at the end of the telephone 24/7 who will help them to overcome barriers as they pop up.

The End-Game - Success

The goal is independent living and sustainable employment at a level commensurate with their potential.

Jon is a former RAMC Sergeant who served 22 years in the army. Jon faces unique challenges with a suspected traumatic brain injury and complex interdependent psychological illnesses.

" I am still alive because of The Rawthey Project, My wife still have a husband and my children still have a father.

Since leaving the Army in 2012 i have really struggled with depression and PTSD and in Sept 2021 i confided in my wife that i wanted to end my life, i needed help, i couldn't see any other way out, i couldn't cope anymore the voices became to loud and that was the only way out i could see.

The Rawthey Project immediately funded a full clinical psychological assessment to get to the root

cause of my problems.

The Rawthey Project really does work, it has not only saved my life but i am sure many others they have helped also".
